Cathexis offers Version Migration packages to keep your installation **up-to-date**, ensuring that your security system benefits from the **latest CathexisVision features**. For your convenience, we also offer **bundled** multi-version CCVM licenses.

CCVM licenses

To migrate to a newer version of CathexisVision, a Camera Version Migration (**CCVM**) license must be added **per IP camera**.

When migrating between releases of CathexisVision that are more than one **annual version** apart, CCVM licenses are required for each upward step / annual version. For example, migrating from CathexisVision 2019 to 2022 would require CCVM licenses for 2020, 2021 and 2022.

How it works



If camera licenses were purchased within 3 months of a new major version release, these licenses will be valid automatically for the new version. In other words, you get a **free upgrade**.

Camera licenses are linked to the software release version that was current at the time they were purchased.

Cathexis provides **bug fixes** and **additional IP camera support** for the major version release's **life cycle**, whatever the number of cameras licensed.

If camera licenses and software are **not** upgraded to the latest major version release, the **software will continue to perform** as usual.
